The proponent has made online application vide proposal no. IA/CG/IND/4652/2010 dated 3rd November, 2017 seeking extension of validity of Environmental Clearance granted vide J- 11011/380/2009-IA.II(I) dated 22/12/2010 & 23/05/2012.

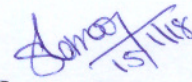
4.0 It was informed that after obtaining the Environmental Clearance, part of the facilities has been implemented and could not go ahead with the implementation of the unimplemented portion of the above referred EC due to severe recession in steel sector (sluggish market condition) and fall in cash flow of the company during the past few years. With the improvement in market condition, the company will likely to implement the remaining unimplemented portion within 3 years.

5.0 The project proponent has made presentation along with Consultant M/s Pioneer Enviro Laboratories & Consultants Pvt. Ltd.

6.0 The proposal was considered in the 26th meeting of Expert Appraisal Committee [EAC] (Industry-I) held during 11th – 13th December, 2017. After detailed deliberations, the committee recommended for extension of validity of EC up to 21st December 2020

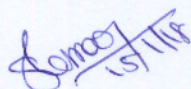
6.0 The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has examined the proposal based on the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry-I) and hereby decided to grant extension of validity of environment clearance for further period of three years i.e. up to 21st December 2020 subject to following conditions:

- i. Project Proponent shall strictly adhere to time schedule submitted to the Ministry regarding completion of the balance works.
 - ii. All other terms and conditions mentioned in the Environment Clearance vide J-11011/380/2009-IA.II(I) dated 22/12/2010 with subsequent amendment dated 23/05/2012 will remain same.
- 7.0 The PP shall obtain fresh environmental clearance in case of change in scope of the project if any.
- 8.0 This issues with the approval of competent authority
